The middle and lower levels easily can accommodate all 150 people in air-conditioned or heated comfort in the event of inclement weather.

While The Carolina Girl's been blessing a lot of weddings since first launching last June, business groups are discovering that she's a wonderful venue for employee-appreciation events or client entertaining. Corporate groups, meeting in Charleston, are using her as an off-site dinner-and-cruise event.
